Distinguished Club Recognition - 16 Clubs Distinguished or better so far; Pathways Committee - 80% overall adoption rate; Club officers - 92% adoption rate; monthly new member adoption rate 48%; Level completions - Level 1-352 members, Level 2-258 members, Level 3-160 members, Level 4-105 members, and Level 5-68 members. Second round of Club officer training records must be submitted to Toastmasters International by May 31st. 2021-22 Club Officer training begins June 4th and 5th.

Pandemic proved to be a challenge. Many clubs are doing well on Zoom. Zoom skills are transferrable to the work and volunteer environment. Over 900 people submitted Pathways awards. Because Trio travel was restricted this year, monies were put into member incentives. So far this year, \$5,345 in Toastmasters gift certificates have been awarded. Advertising on social media has ramped up this year. Incentives are continuing until year end, and more gift certificates will be awarded. Clubs will soon need to decide whether to become hybrid clubs. The Trio is ready to point you towards resources for the equipment needed to have a hybrid club. Division G	Remove three ineligible clubs: Politically Incorrect Toastmasters Club, Wafermasters Club, and BurnsMasters. Move Speakers With Spirit to Area 84. No further changes.
Division H	Remove three ineligible clubs: RA Chiptalkers, Barnhart Toastmasters and Platt Electric Supply. Add prospective club Sunset Talkers to Area 91. Add prospective clubs Downtown Jam and PR Masters to Area 92. No further changes.



Amendment to D7 2021 Realignment Report

Background: Area 31 has seven Clubs, so the original realignment proposal adds Area 34 and three Clubs will move into that new Area.

At the D7 District Executive Committee Meeting on April 18, 2021, a motion was made, seconded and passed by unanimous vote to amend the Realignment Report as follows:

"Renumber the Areas in Division B to better group their clubs based on geographical locations. Specifically, all Clubs in the Eugene area will be in two adjacent Areas, Areas 31 and 32. Area 31 remains as is, Area 32 becomes Area 33, Area 33 becomes Area 34, and the new Area 34 becomes Area 32."

The amended Realignment Report was approved by the District Executive Committee for referral to the full District Council at the Annual Business Meeting on May 15, 2021. The amended section of the report is attached.
