If you are looking for a Path that is the most flexible to any speech topic and requiring the least preparation, Presentation Mastery with it's public speaking focus may be a good selection for you.



#### **3.** Completing a Project – Logging in, navigation basics, Ice Breaker completion:


Go to https://www.toastmasters.org. And click on "Login"




#### Click on "Pathways."




Then, click on "Go to Base Camp."


#### Access your path and track your progress here.

Select the Open Curriculum button to access the projects on your path. Before launching projects, **ensure that your pop-up blocker is turned off.** 

If you want to access completed or archived items, use the Active dropdown menu below. If you need to archive an item, select the arrow adjacent to the Launc or Open button and choose Move to Archived Transcript.

Click on "Begin" or the down-arrow at the bottom to start navigating the project window






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
The down-arrow menu on the left will allow accessing any page within the project window any time. Clicking the "Begin" button will also allow access to each project window page, one at a time.


Using either method, I would recommend going through each project window page in order, initially stopping with "Your Evaluation" prior to giving your speech.



There are only 5 total options for navigating within every project window. The 4 listed at the top of the picture below are necessary for page navigation, as well as accessing all info on a given project window page. The 5<sup>th</sup> option is the down-arrow already referred to, located at the bottom of every project window page.



#### 4. Completing Level 1 (same process for all Level completions):



Now that all the Level 1 projects are complete, you will see that you can "Activate" your Level completion module.




The status for the Level 1 Completion item will show as "Pending Completion Approval."

After your VPE submits the approval for Level 1, the status for this Level completion item will change to "Completed." Also, notice the blue check marks next to both the Level 1 Completion module you just accessed. As well, there is a check mark next to "Level 1" on the left side of the screen.

You receive a certificate of accomplishment when you complete Level 1. To view and print your certificate, select "View Certificate."
